

COVID-19 Scenarios

Individual has COVID-19 SYMPTOMS but has NOT had close contact with a person diagnosed with COVID-19

If at home: Stay home and notify School Nurse, Carol-Ann Ball (caball@whitbyschool.org), 203-983-6618 immediately (do not wait until the beginning of the next school day), contact your physician for appropriate evaluation.

If at school: Students will remain masked, adhere to strict physical distancing, and be escorted to the nurse's office to be assessed. Parent/caregiver will be notified to pick-up their child. Symptomatic faculty/staff will leave school immediately.

If symptoms arise on the bus: Students should remain masked and follow the measures listed above upon arrival to school. **They must not be sent home on the bus.**

Next Steps

- Consult with your healthcare provider.
- Schedule testing if directed by the physician.
- If tested is required, contact Carol-Ann Ball as soon as test results are received.

Individual has COVID-19 SYMPTOMS AND CLOSE CONTACT to a person diagnosed with COVID-19

Individual does not have COVID-19 symptoms BUT had close contact to someone diagnosed with COVID-19

TEST RESULTS

Individual Tests Negative
Return to school, 24 hrs without symptoms

Individual Tests Positive
Self-isolation for at least 10 days

Individual Not Tested
Return to school, 24 hrs without symptoms

Individual Tests Negative
Quarantine for 14 days from exposure time

Individual Tests Positive
Self-isolation for at least 10 days

Individual Not Tested
Quarantine for 14 days from time of exposure

Individual Tests Negative
Self-quarantine for 14 days

Individual Tests Positive
Remain at home for at least 10 days

Individual Not Tested
Quarantine for 14 days from time of exposure

TEACHING MODE

Teacher support and student learning materials will be provided.
Cohort remains in school

Teacher support and student learning materials will be provided.
School nurse determines if circumstances warrant cohort quarantine

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COMMUNICATIONS

- The parent of the student with symptoms will be called immediately.
- A notification email will be sent to cohort classroom parents and a separate email sent to all parents and faculty/staff.
- For staff and faculty, alerts will go out to the entire Whitby Community.
- Additional communications will follow as needed.

A physician's clearance to return to school is required for those persons who test COVID-19 positive.
