As students progress through the language acquisition phases the expectations for each indicator will become increasingly complex, due to the progression in the development of each skill.

<b>Outcome</b>	<b>Indicator</b>
<b>Listening</b>	Listens actively Follows directions
<b>Speaking</b>	Construct simple statements and questions Expresses ideas, feelings, and needs Applies language in a familiar context Pronounces words clearly.
<b>Reading</b>	Recognizes words in context Comprehends simple sentences and short text Begins to read with accuracy Answers simple comprehension questions
<b>Writing</b>	Writes simple sentences Begins to express basic information in writing Begins to develop accuracy when writing
